INTRODUCING OUR SCHOOL VISION

MARK 12:31

You'll hear and see these words a lot at school! It's our SCHOOL VISION. A vision is a big dream shared by a community of people.

WHERE DOES IT COME FROM?

Our SCHOOL VISION comes from the bible. The bible tells us about things that Jesus said and did. Jesus talked to people about God and told them how He wants them to live. Jesus told people to 'Love your neighbour as yourself'.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

Jesus's words mean:

TREAT OTHER PEOPLE HOW YOU WOULD LIKE THEM TO TREAT YOU.

You'd like other people to show you love, kindness and respect, wouldn't you? Jesus tells us to do the same thing for others!

In the prayer that he taught his friends (The Lord's Prayer), Jesus says that we should ask God to forgive <u>us</u> when we do the wrong thing, and that <u>we</u> should also forgive other people who do wrong things to us.

HOW CAN I SHOW THIS VALUE AT HOME?



- If someone hurts your feelings, try to say 'it's ok' when they say sorry to you.

- If there is someone you've fallen out with or haven't spoken to for a while, see if you can be friends again.
